- (g) After processing the application, the data will be retained for future administrative use. The data will be kept confidential and are only accessible to the school. The applicant has the right to obtain access to and request correction of any personal information of himself/herself held by the school. Requests for such access should be made in writing to the Principal.
- (h) All applicants must complete the application form fully and truthfully. The information supplied by the applicant in this application form will be used by the school to determine the appropriate level of financial assistance to be granted. Any misrepresentation or omission may lead to disqualification from current as well as future applications and/or immediate payment of the school fee in full without any remission and possibly court proceedings.
